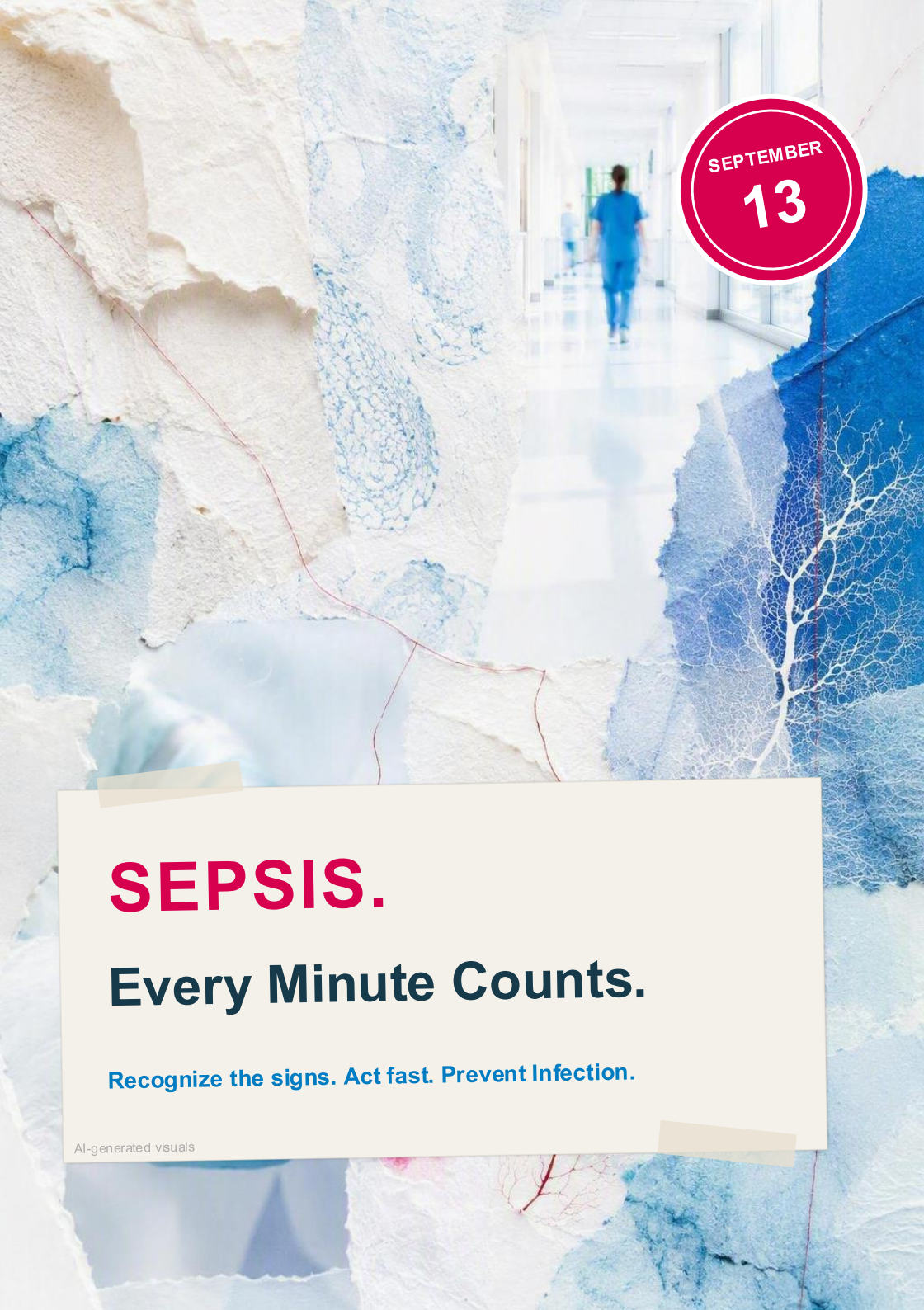

How to spot sepsis

- S** Slurred speech or confusion
- E** Extreme shivering or muscle pain / fever
- P** Passing no urine all day
- S** Severe breathlessness
- I** “I feel like I’m going to die”
- S** Skin mottled or discolored
